President's Report to the Faculty Senate – January 22, 2014

- 1. Letters of congratulation sent on behalf of Faculty Senate to:
 - Dr. Bette Bergeron, Provost-designate
 - Dr. Stephen Hegedus, Dean-designate, School of Education
 - Mr. Robert DeMezzo, Director of Residence Life
- 2. Appointed to represent the faculty on a committee to review bids for the next bookstore vendor: Ms. Sara Johnson (NUR) and Dr. Vara Neverow (ENG).
- 3. **UCF Resolution on LEP course caps.** Not approved by Pres. Papazian (see table below).
- 4. Recent meetings at which the FS was represented. (See Attachment A)
- 5. **Faculty Creative Activity Research Grants.** 68 applications received. 29 funded. Originally, fringe was not charged to the fund, but this year \$25,000 was taken out for fringe, reducing awards from 34 to 24; the Provost found funding to raise the number of awards to 29. The Provost suggested the Faculty Senate consider additional possibilities for the grants (e.g., use of funds for equipment, supplies, student workers; inclusion of several larger grants). The Executive Committee shall:
 - Explore additional possibilities for grant awards (see above)
 - Advocate removal of fringe charge from Faculty Creative Activity Research Grants fund
 - Advocate increased allotment for FCARGs and creative activity-related travel, per original plan
 - Consider original plan for distribution of travel funds separately from CBA travel funds

The appreciation of the Faculty Senate has been expressed to the University Grants Committee, chaired by Dr. Lisa Vitale, and to Provost Kennedy.
