 - Common/consolidated calendar is being developed for the 17 ConnSCU institutions for AY 16;
 complicated by different dates in several CBAs
 - SCSU will participate in UCLA Faculty Survey this semester; the faculty is asked to participate
 - FAAR completion rate: 60-70%; Senate asked to encourage higher participation
 - Exercise Science Dept. has voted unanimously to relocate to School of Health & Human Services
 - Additional funding for travel this year (to be discussed in Finance Committee report)
