WHAT YOU'LL STUDY

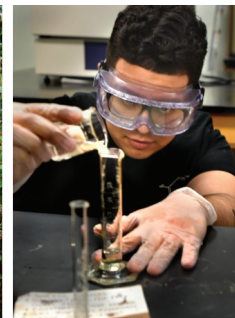
